EUROSAI WGEA Massive Open Online Course on auditing water issues

This is with regard to the Massive Open Online Course (MOOC) "Auditing water issues" developed by the members of EUROSAI Working Group on Environmental Auditing (WGEA), including your office, in collaboration with the University of Tartu.


The water audit MOOC was launched in November 2018 and sparked wide interest with close to 300 participants initially signing up to take the course. By the end of December, 185 students from 47 countries had completed all assignments and received a certificate from the University of Tartu. Three quarters of the course alumni are working in 34 different Supreme Audit Institutions of six INTOSAI regions, but there are also university students and employees of other government institutions and private companies among the graduates.

I wish to thank you for the kind support your office has lent to the MOOC project. The input to various parts of study materials and the Prespa National Park ecosystem audit case provided by your office proved integral to the architecture of the course. My team greatly values the good cooperation they had with Mr Aulent Guri and Mr Dorel Balliu during the project.

The MOOC will be run again in the autumn of 2019, with some small adjustments to be made based on the generally positive feedback of course participants. We will approach your office's MOOC contacts prior to that and they are very welcome to propose any amendments and comments to further improve the course materials.

I am looking forward to further good cooperation between our offices bilaterally as well as in EUROSAI WGEA in the future.
